- Get one free conditional admission application to any of our Host Institutions
- · Receive free university counseling while studying at ELS
- Receive an academic transcript
- Those students who complete level 112 of the Intensive Program-English for Academic Purposes will receive our Level 112 Certificate of Completion. This official document is accepted as proof of English proficiency for admission at ELS partner colleges and universities.

EAP Students benefit from morning classes that are designed to build a foundation for communicative competency: Structure and Speaking Practice (or Language Studies), Vocabulary Enrichment (or Skills Enhancement Classes in Masters levels) and one lesson in our Language Technology Center. Afternoons are dedicated to Reading and Writing classes.
